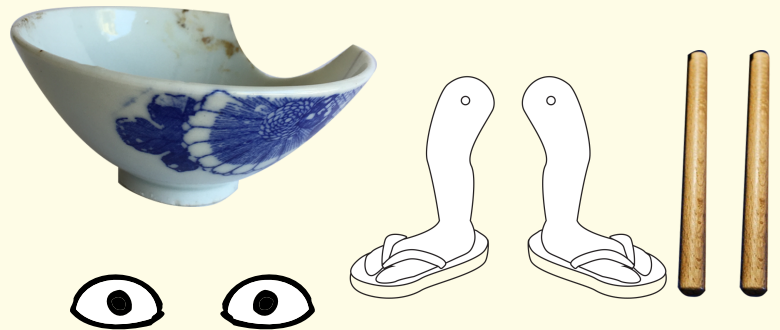


Tsukumogami Japanese Tool Monsters
